Dear Rector Menicucci:

Mr. Wernimont, whom you met at our offices in New York, has informed me of the discussions which you and he held regarding Mr. Wander Said who would like a scholarship to enable him to work for a year with Dr. Donald Freebairn in Mexico in the field of agricultural economics.
